**29. ELIZABETH**, Princess of England (6-29), dau. of **EDWARD I** (1-27) and **ELEANOR OF CASTILE** (110-30); m. 1302, **HUMPHREY VIII DE BOHUN** (97-31), 4<sup>th</sup> Earl of Hereford and 1<sup>st</sup> Earl of Essex. (CP IV: 669, X: 118).

**30. SIR WILLIAM DE BOHUN, K.G.**, b. 1310/12, d. Sept. 1360, fought at Crecy, cr. 6<sup>th</sup> Earl of Northampton, 16 Mar. 1336/7; m., as 2<sup>nd</sup> husb., 1335/8, **ELIZABETH DE BADLESMERE** (65-34). (CP I: 245, 373 note c, IV: 669, IX: 664-667).

**31. ELIZABETH DE BOHUN**, d. 3 Apr. 1385; m. abt. 28 Sept. 1359, **RICHARD FITZ ALAN** (20-31, 60-33), b. 1346, beheaded 21 Sept. 1397, 15<sup>th</sup> Earl of Arundel and Surrey. (CP I: 244-245, IV: 669).

**32. ELIZABETH FITZ ALAN**, d. 8 July 1425; m. (1) Sir William de Montagu; m.(2) July 1384, **THOMAS DE MOWBRAY** (16-32), 1<sup>st</sup> Duke of Norfolk, b. 22 Mar. 1365/6, d. Venice, 22 Sept. 1399; m. (3) bef. 19 Aug. 1401, Sir Robert Goushill, of Haveringham, Notts.; m. (4) bef. 3 July 1414, Sir Gerard Usflete. (CP IX: 604, XII (1): 604).

**33. ELIZABETH GOUSHILL**, b. abt. 1402; m. **ROBERT WINGFIELD** (15A-33), b. 1403, of Letheringham, Suffolk, d. 1451. (CP IX: 604 n; G-A. Moriarty in *NEHGR* 103: 295).

**34. ELIZABETH WINGFIELD**, d. 1497, m. bef. 1462 Sir William Brandon, Knt., d. 1491. (*DNB* 6: 218-22; *NEHGR* 103: 102-107; TAG 47 (1971): 205).

**35. ELEANOR BRANDON**, aunt of Charles Brandon, Duke of Suffolk; m. John Glemham of Glemham, co. Suffolk. (*NEHGR* 102: 95).

**36. ANNE GLEMHAM**, m. Henry Palgrave (Pagrave), Esq., b. abt. 1470, will proved 14 Jan 1517/1518, of Little Pagrave and Thrupton, Norfolk, son of John Pagrave and Margaret Yelverton, dau. of Sir William Yelverton. Monumental brass for Henry Pagrave and Anne, his wife, in parish church of Barningham Northwood, Norfolk. **37. THOMAS PALGRAVE, GENT.**, b. 1505/10, of Thrupton; m. Alice Gunton, dau. of Robert Gunton of Thrupton. (*NEHGR* 102: 95).

**38. REV. EDWARD PALGRAVE**, bapt. Thrupton, 21 Jan. 1540/41, d. Dec. 1623, Rector of Barnham Broom, 1567-1623; name of wife unknown. (*Palgrave Memorials*, 140; *NEHGR* 102: 96).

**39. DR. RICHARD PALGRAVE**, b. abt. 1585, d. Oct. 1651, physician at Wymondham, Norfolk, and Charlestown, Mass., 1630; freeman 18 May 1631; m. Anna, maiden name unkn., d. Roxbury, 17 Feb. 1669. (*NEHGR* 102: 95-97; Moriarty Notebooks).

**40. MARY PALGRAVE**, b. abt. 1618/1619, m. abt. 1637, Roger Wellington of Watertown, Mass., ancestors of Roger Sherman, the Signer of the Declaration of Independence, 1776. (*NEHGR* 102: 97).

**40. SARAH PALGRAVE**, (dau. of Gen. 39), b. abt. 1620/1621, d. 1665, m. abt. 1648, John Alcock, of Roxbury, Mass. (Harvard Coll., 1646), physician at Roxbury.

**40. ELIZABETH PALGRAVE**, (dau. of Gen. 39), bapt. Wymondham, 10 Apr. 1626, d. Boston, Mass. abt. 1707, m. by 8 June 1651, John Edwards, Sr., of Green Bank, Stepney, London. (This line through John Glemham to Edward I was given in the *Boston Evening Transcript*, 12 Feb. 1930, Note 9665; and Jan. 1928, Note 6455; TAG 25: 24-26).
